	The engineer will be appointed by the contractor, and allowance must be made for 3 inspections and the submission of a final certificate by the engineer. A quotation of the prospective engineer plus a short CV must be submitted to the municipality for approval under the Contingency Sum, before the engineer's appointment can be finalised by the contractor.

l.3	Install new burglar bars, tight fit (inside of frame); transparent square bars made of a high quality polycarbonate (Ultra High Impact rating of 100), with an outer layer of ultraviolet protection on both sides, about 5mm thick and 50mm broad. Please note that the bars must be secured to fully galvanised steel tubes using stainless-steel button-head screws fastened to zinc-plated rivnuts, and these steel tubes, framing the bars, must in turn be securely bolted (using coach screws and UL8 Rawl plugs) to the window reveal. This is an extra security measure as opposed to simply fixing the polycarbonate bars directly to the aluminium or wooden window frames. Bidders must	R
